Trinity Health's Family Birth Center brings together labor and delivery, postpartum and the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU). Pediatrics is also on the third floor to create a comprehensive center for women and children.

Within this space, our 12 private birthing suites, some ready to accommodate twins and triplets, provide the comforts of home combined with expert medical care and technology. Our luxurious, modern suites come with their own bathroom, a flat screen TV and a couch that converts into a bed. A family lounge also is available with a kitchenette and seating areas if families wish to step away from the bedside.

The NICU also features a rooming-in program that allows families to stay overnight in a specially designated room before the baby is discharged. This program supports parents in learning how to care for their newborn with the guidance and support of NICU staff, ensuring a smooth transition to set up families for success once they take their baby home.

When it comes to treating children, our pediatric unit is designed around their needs. Children have their own treatment and therapy rooms — where furniture and decor are kid-friendly and equipment is out of view.



We can offer more leading treatment options with 12 state-of-the-art operating rooms designed for surgical specialties like cardiology, neurosurgery, orthopedics, general surgery and urology. Each room utilizes advanced monitoring and minimally invasive systems, like the da Vinci Xi System, to help ensure better outcomes. We've also introduced a new cardiac cath lab and interventional radiology suite, excelling in treating strokes, arrhythmias and heart attacks in less time, which ultimately saves lives.

Central to our new hospital design is a commitment to humanizing healthcare.

This is evident in our Intensive Care Unit (ICU), with spacious, treatment-ready rooms and designated spaces for families who play a crucial role in recovery.

An expanded Emergency Department and Level II Trauma Center with highly coordinated and expert care teams.


In a medical emergency, how you respond makes a world of difference.

Our new 33,000 square-foot Emergency Department and Level II Trauma Center is designed to deliver lifesaving care and offer you more comfort and privacy.

We've streamlined our registration process. There are dedicated areas for adults, children and behavioral health patients, making a visit to the trauma center more comfortable.

Ambulances now arrive at a dedicated entrance, ensuring that individuals with minor injuries are separated from more critical cases. Radiology, advanced imaging, cath lab, interventional radiology lab and the operating rooms are now located nearby to ensure swifter and more coordinated treatment.
